- We should evaluate in August, if September is realistic.

That we revisit in August 2020 and make a plan for opening the St. Paul's International churches in September 2020 at the earliest. CARRIED

Using Space for Rental Groups

- We should evaluate on a case by case basis
- We need to have our own COVID-19 quidelines
- We should prepare a set of guidelines so we are ready for requests

Youth Group

- Carrie Frostad sent an email about the youth group
- She has also been in contact with Wilma Woods (St. Gilles Anglican) and Lori James (Trinity Lutheran)
- Currently the youth group is meeting twice a week on Zoom
- To prevent "Zoom Gloom" aka spending too much time online they are doing 45 min / session, as recommended

- During the summer months, they are thinking of 3-4 larger gatherings
- Perhaps a town wide scavenger hunt, drive in movie, or car bingo where the winner honks their horn
- So there are three choices. Zoom, discontinue for summer, or have 3 larger meet in person but continue to physically distance activities
- Carrie is in Regina, but her kids would be willing to come to Estevan for the larger activities
- Carrie is also okay with continuing to use Zoom from Regina

Canadian Blood Services

- Canadian Blood Services would the auditorium for a blood clinic in Estevan
- They also approached other groups in Estevan and are planning to do actual site evaluations of all the potential sites to see which would be suitable.
- Insurance and COVID-19 Canadian Blood Services have their own insurance and they can add us to their policy
- They gave us a list of what we would have to do before and after the clinic
- 2 pm 7 pm would be the times of the actual clinic but there would be set up and take down times before and after as well.
- Canadian Blood Services would be willing to pay our normal rental fees and pay extra for the over and above cleaning (for our cleaning staff)
- Vic Wiebe ran this proposal by Tracy Murton and she didn't see any difficulty with this proposal
