

# d) Canadian Emergency Business Account (CEBA)

- This \$55 billion program provides interest-free loans of up to \$60,000 to small businesses and not-for-profits.
- Repaying the balance of the loan on or before December 31, 2022 will result in loan forgiveness of 33 percent (up to \$20,000).
- As of October 26, 2020, eligibility for CEBA expanded by removing the previous March 1, 2020 condition for having an active business chequing/operating account. With this removal, eligible businesses can

now apply after opening a business chequing/operating account with their primary financial institution.

- As of December 4, 2020 approved CEBA applicants can now receive a \$60,000 loan. CEBA applicants who have received the \$40,000 CEBA loan may apply the CEBA expansion, which provides eligible businesses with an additional \$20,000 of financing.
- CEBA is available from more than 220 financial institutions across the country.
- **Recommend** the St. Paul's Leadership Team instruct the Treasurer to apply for the CEBA loan and ensure adherence to all its obligations.
