 - We will need a motion at the next Leadership Team meeting to cancel the motion from the May 12, 2021 meeting that stated that we deny group rental requests until we have been open to in-person worship services for at least one month. We did not have quorum at this meeting, so this motion could not be made at this time, nor was this meeting scheduled to be a formal meeting.

6. Elections Canada

- In anticipation for an upcoming federal election, Elections Canada has requested to rent some of our chairs and tables that they can move to where they will be having their temporary offices, for the time required before, after, and during the election.
- We can go ahead and rent them out; they won't be taking all of our chairs and tables, so it shouldn't be an issue for any activities we might have planned.
