### 9.1 Rural Connect

- Did we have any feedback?
  - Not much of anything yet...
    - Not our traditions and there was a little bit of disconnect.
    - It's fine but not sure yet
  - Start times of church services are a little bit confusing... 10 am or 10:30 am or 11 am but it is something that could be fixed going into the future.
  - If we do this, it still does not address other needs like pastoral care, funerals, and weddings if we do Rural connect
  - Emily Gillies is willing to lead a conversation in the service on April 23 about Rural connect and how to move forward with the Community of Faith profile
- As of right now, hiring a full time minister for a 3 year term is unrealistic.
- A proposed idea for going forward in the short term future is to do rural connect for 3 Sundays per month and on the first Sunday of each month have pulpit supply for Estevan and North Portal, and continue having the ecumenical services on the 5<sup>th</sup> Sundays of the month, when a month has 5 Sundays.
- Do we need to have a congregational meeting of St. Paul's International Charge to discuss this and how to proceed, including if we choose to pause the Community of Faith profile process?

  - That on May 7, 2023 we have a joint pastoral charge congregational meeting for the purpose of a discussion of ministry in the pastoral charge, if such a meeting is deemed necessary. CARRIED.


