## Living Skies Region Archives Update

Since the 1980s, the Saskatchewan Conference Archives, now Living Skies Regional Council Archives, has enjoyed a beneficial and positive partnership with the Provincial Archives of Saskatchewan (PAS). This allowed us to lease storage space for our archival records at the PAS's excellent storage facility. Additionally, for the last decade or so, the Region's wonderful half-time Archivist, Madeleine Mcluhan-Myers, is a full-time employee of the PAS who we were able to "lease" for 17.5 hours per week. Unfortunately, the PAS has decided to end this arrangement. As of April 1, 2023, Madeleine will no longer be our Regional Archivist, and as of April 1, 2025, we will no longer be able to store our records at PAS. Our staff and the PAS are working together to make this as smooth a transition as possible.

As we enter this time of transition, we remain committed to enabling access to the records, their continued safe preservation, and our commitment to reconciliation and the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action as they relate to Archives.

There may be some growing pains as we work out a system for reference, and some delays in response will occur. Priority will be given for requests related to: baptism, marriage, and burial records; residential schools/ colonizing institutions; property commission; and community of faith's requests for their own records.

With few exceptions, the Living Skies Archives will not be accepting new record transfers until we are fully moved into a new space. If the records are in danger of being lost or damaged, then please be in touch and we will accommodate a transfer, but if the records are not at immediate risk then we ask that they be stored at a local United Church for now.

## House Groups

The House Groups have been re-visited. House Groups are assigned responsibilities for a month. House Group leaders are responsible to get greeters. Greeters are asked:

- to get a key from the office ahead of their Sunday;
- unlock the doors of the church;
- greet the worshippers;
- bring offering forward during the service;
- ensure candles are out and lights turned off;
- lock the doors after service; and
- drop the key in the brown mailbox outside the front door.

Scripture readers are assigned by the office from a list of volunteers. As part of their duties the readers are asked to light the Christ Candle.

May's hosting House group will be "The Way Walkers".

#### **Reverend Jason Richards**

We are saddened to hear of the death of

Jason Richards on April 13, 2023 at the age of 41. He will be missed by St, Paul's International Pastoral Charge family.

Jason was born in Saskatoon. He found his calling at St. Andrew's College, Saskatoon, receiving his Masters of Divinity Degree with the United Church of Canada in 2016.



Spending a semester Soul Korea, he completed an internship at Kangnam, Korea where he met Young. Jason completed his student ministry at Alameda, SK. His first call to ministry was St. Paul's United Church, 2016, in Estevan. His second call to ministry brought him to St. Marys United Church, St. Marys, Ontario from 2019 until his passing.

We are reminded of his words at the end of each service, "God is good!" "All the time!"

A memorial service for Jason will be held at the St. Mary's United Church on Friday, April 28, 2023 at 11:00 am (**9:00 am our time**). The service will be officiated by
