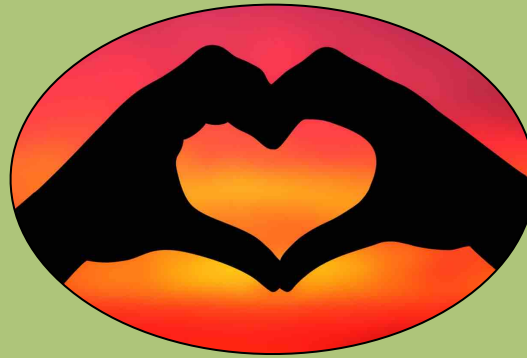

Scheduling Your Wedding

The Earlier, the Better

The church should be booked for a wedding as soon as you determine a date for the event. An early booking helps to make sure you have both the date and time you want. On booking your wedding, arrangements can be made for a preliminary interview with the minister and an outline of music requirements provided to the music personnel.

Flowers and other Decor

Many couples wish to decorate the church with flowers or other suitable decorations. Please arrange the set-up of any displays with the church office.

In the United Church, we understand a wedding to be a special worship where a community gives thanks for the love between two people, and those people covenant with one another and with God to love and honour one another. The gathered community also promises to nurture the couple in their life together.

Legal Requirements



The marriage license is to be obtained at the registry of your choice and delivered to the church one month before your wedding. Based upon the information provided by you, the church will complete the required "Registration of Marriage" form and forward it along with the marriage license to eHealth Saskatchewan. Following your ceremony you will receive a marriage certificate from the church. A government issued marriage certificate may be ordered from eHealth Saskatchewan.

Music



Music is a powerful memory-maker. Our church organist is available to play the organ and piano for your ceremony. It is important that you discuss your music requirements well in advance of the wedding date.

We recognize the growing popularity of recorded music. We are well experienced in synchronizing chosen songs with the order of service.

Photos and Videos



Capturing the Moment

We know the importance of capturing the moment in stills and video. For professional photographers, taking pictures is allowed during the processional, recessional, and signing of the register. We will also remind guests that as this is a religious service, to please refrain from taking photos during the ceremony.

Videographers may set up in a place approved by the minister.
